Laura Hughes gave a brief report of last year. New information is on the website, listing the physical fitness opportunities open to the public on the SISD campuses and Child Nutrition information. SMS participated in the 2018 Texas Youth Tobacco Survey and did receive \$300.

The flu shot clinics have already been held on each campus. The Parker County Hospital District had vaccines available on all campuses and there was an average of 130 given on each.

Shane Strickland informed the members of an opportunity to serve on the Community Health Improvement for Wise County. He also reported that the district has purchased 2 ionization machines to help with the disinfection of classrooms.

Laura Hughes discussed actions for the new year. Mr. Strickland informed the committee that our Wellness Policy and Wellness Plan meets regulations and does not need to be updated. Juul (vaping) awareness was discussed as well as harmful phone apps. Goals will be discussed and voted on at the next meeting.
