Laura Hughes welcomed everyone and introduced the new members of the SHAC committee to the existing members. She also mentioned the new SHS nurse, Ashely Hall, will also be joining the committee.

She began the meeting by reviewing the 2018-2019 SHAC goals. She reminded members the different ways the district has addressed vaping awareness and dangerous phone apps. She mentioned the programs started last year are still continuing. There has already been a district wide Internet Safety Meeting on Nov. 4th led by Jeff Swain, the Assistant DA for Parker County. Shane Strickland reported the meeting was attended by many parents and was very informative.

The district has already held the flu vaccine clinics. Over 100 students and employee received shots on each campus.

Laura Hughes opened the floor for nominations for 2019-2020 chairman and co-chairman. Shelby Willis nominated Laura Hughes for chairman, the motion was seconded by Vicky Trichel, passed unanimously. Audrey Haugen nominated Shelby Willis for co-chair, the motion was seconded by Kim Nash and it passed unanimously.

Before deciding goals for the 2019-2020 school year, members were given a summary of activities that have occurred over the summer. All SISD employees are now trained in the "Stop the Bleed" program. This program is a national awareness campaign that trains people so they can assist in a bleeding emergency before professional help arrives. The Parker County Department of Health has donated medical kits so that each campus has at least one.

Kim Nash reported that there were no major policy changes for child nutrition over the summer. She said they have introduced some new menu items and are receiving positive feedback from the students.

Chairman Laura Hughes then suggested setting goals for the 2019-2020 school year. The first would be to evaluate our current Wellness Policy and to make updates. The second was Seizure Awareness. Committee members agreed to the suggested goals.

The meeting was adjourned at 2.43.
