Springtown Independent School District District Instructional Advisory Committee (DIAC) Meeting

On this 20th day of February 2020, the District Instructional Advisory Committee (DIAC) of the Springtown Independent School District met at 4:00 p.m. in the Springtown ISD Administration Boardroom.

Assistant Superintendent Shane Strickland called the meeting to order at 4:02 p.m. and welcomed the 2019-2020 DIAC members (30 members were present). Mr. Strickland went over what would be discussed in the meeting.

At 4:07 p.m. Superintendent Mike Kelley began discussion on the 2020-2021 school calendar. He put calendar examples “A”, “B”, and “C” on the projector screen and led discussions on the pros and cons of each with the committee and attendees. The biggest discussion was over the ending of school, holidays, and comp days. The key differences between proposals "A","B", “C” and “D” include the end date of May 20th May 27th and May 28th for our students. All three calendars meet the 187 day teacher contract requirements and the 75,600 minutes required for students.

The committee agreed on Assistant Superintendent Strickland sending a Calendar “E” to the board to be approved. A motion was made by Bradley Bryant, and Megan Hibbetts seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

At 5:06p.m.there was a chance for open forum. No one had anything to add, so Assistant Superintendent Strickland adjourned the meeting at 5:06 p.m.
