Springtown Independent School District District Instructional Advisory Committee (DIAC) Meeting

On this 11th day of September 2019, the District Instructional Advisory Committee (DIAC) of the Springtown Independent School District met at 4:00 p.m. in the Springtown ISD Administration Boardroom.

Assistant Superintendent Shane Strickland called the meeting to order at 4:04 p.m. and welcomed the 2019-2020 DIAC members. Assistant Superintendent Strickland reviewed the roles and responsibilities of the DIAC.
